The Fiebing House, constructed by local historian and author John Rolfe Burroughs (See above.) in 1947, is an excellent example of the pioneer log Rustic style of architecture in that it is hand-crafted, displays traditional building techniques, is small and modest, and incorporates locally available materials. The home is one-and-one-half stories, has side gables, a concrete foundation, a rough-log post porch, projecting eaves, and a one-story section with a flat roof. Although a mud room has been added and the interior has been modernized to some extent, the original structure still maintains its integrity and represents the Post-war expansion of Steamboat Springs.
